The undersigned, desiring to form a corporation, not for profit, under Sections 1702.01 et seq., Revised Code of Ohio, do hereby certify:

FIRST. The name of said corporation shall be Ohio Mosquito Control Association

SECOND. The place in Ohio where the principal office of the corporation is to be located is

THIRD. The purpose or purposes for which said corporation is formed are:

- 1) The purpose of the Ohio Mosquito Control Association is to promote mosquito control in Ohio whenever same is feasible; to maintain interest in areas where mosquitoes are now being controlled; to keep up with the latest developments in control methods; to disseminate information concerning mosquitoes and diseases they transmit to its membership and the general public through publications and meetings; and to unite and coordinate common interests and efforts.
- 2) The Ohio Mosquito Control Association is organized exclusively for chartitable, educational and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).
- 3) No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendereed and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in article three hereof. No part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) ary political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. So withstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

4) Upon the dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purposes of the corporation in such manner, or tothe American Mosquito Control Association or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as as an exempt organization of organizations under section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954. (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law, as the Board of Directors shall determine. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principle office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

FOURTH. The following persons, not less than three, shall serve said corporation as trustees until the first annual meeting or other meeting called to elect trustees.
